
- Jai Shri Mataji

Ceiling Timber Panels


We are hoping to reuse the current timber doors that were made by David Flesser as timber panels for the ceiling or as a timber wall feature. This will connect the old with the new.





Brick Tiles

We have been able to incorporate brick work into the design of the new Puja Hall through the use of brick tiles.
These brick tiles are made from recycled bricks and are about ³/₄ size of a normal brick.
