


## Tour Routes

#### **Southern Route**

Adelaide-Regional Victoria-Melbourne-Hobart-Launcestonflight to Brisbane

Temperature Range: 2°C to 16°C

Route details: 7m people, 1,500+ km





### **East-West Route** (To be finalised)

Perth-Bunbury-Augusta-Melbourne-Canberra-Orange-Toowoomba-Brisbane

Temperature Range: 0°C to 18°C

Route details: 4m people, 2,300+ km



#### **North-East Coastal Route**



Cairns-Townsville-Mackay Region-Gold Coast- Sunshine Coast-Brisbane

Temperature Range: 8°C to 26°C

Route details: 5m people, 1,800 km+

#### **Mid-East Coastal Route**



Sydney-Wollongong-Canberra -Newcastle-Taree-Coffs Harbour-Byron Bay-Brisbane

Temperature Range: 7°C to 21°C

Route details: 6.5m people, 1,000+ km
