

Varanasi is easily accessible from all parts of the country. Very well connected by road, rail and air, the City offers convenient and comfortable travelling options to and from other cities of India.



How to reach Varanasi by Air

Located just 18 km away from the main city, Lal Bahadur Shastri International Airport serves Varanasi. It is the nearest airport to the city, Varanasi airport is well connected with all the major cities of the country. One does not need to worry how to reach Varanasi by air as it has very good connectivity. Get easy flights from Delhi to Varanasi, Flights from Mumbai to Varanasi and other cities. There is both Domestic and International flights available from Babatpur Airport Varanasi.

How to reach Varanasi by Rail

The country is well connected with each other by rail. Varanasi has following railway stations

- Varanasi Junction railway station (station code: BSB), also known as Varanasi Cantt railway station, is the main railway station serving the city of Varanasi.
- 2. <u>Banaras railway station</u> (station code: BSBS), formerly known as **Manduadih railway station**, is situated in Manduadih area of Varanasi. It is a major station of Varanasi.
- Mughalsarai Junction, officially known as Pt. Deen Dayal Upadhyaya Junction, (station code: DDU, formerly MGS) is a railway station in the town of Mughalsarai in the Indian state of Uttar Pradesh

How to reach Varanasi by Road

The Uttar Pradesh State Buses as well as the private bus services makes it possible for all to access the city with ease and at a reasonable cost. It solves the query of many who are worried about how to reach Varanasi by road. There are frequent buses from Varanasi to the Allahabad(120 km), Gorakhpur (165 km), Patna (215 km), Lucknow (270 km) and Ranchi (325 km) from Varanasi.





9. Introduction to Varanasi




Varanasi is one of the oldest cities in the world. It is also known as Benares, **Banaras**, and **Kashi**. This city on the banks of the Ganges in northern India was founded by a Hindu deity named "**Shiva**" along with "**Brahma**" and "**Vishnu**" more than 5,000 years ago. On account of its incredible age and religious significance, Varanasi's culture is quintessentially Indian and profoundly diverse.

Mornings begin with the melodious chime of temple bells as dawn settles into day; evenings fade into nights at the banks of Ganga, with spectacular aartis as the priests chant in unison. A day in Varanasi, and you wouldn't wonder why it is considered to be India's most spiritual city.

Varanasi is the spiritual capital of India and its holiest city. From Treta Yuga, through Dwapara Yuga till today Kashi has retained its religious importance and sanctity. It is here that the Pandavas prayed to Lord Shiva for success in the Mahabharata war.

Besides its over 23000 temples, Varanasi is a flourishing cultural hub. Classical music and dance have a notable presence here. Hardly a wedding in India is complete without Banarasi silk sarees. Street food in Varanasi is in a class of its own, making it a foodie's paradise.

10. About Shri Kashi Vishwanath Temple (History)



Varanasi is Shiva's city, and not visiting him would leave your trip incomplete. Kashi Vishwanath temple is one of the twelve jyotirlingas of Shiva, and the temple was found in the 14th century. There are many facts and beliefs about the Vishwanath temple, and it is said that any wish can come true if it is made after seeing the golden chhatra. So after visiting Kashi darbar, don't forget to visit Kaal Bhairav Mandir, also known as Kashi k kotwal (the protractor or Varanasi). All the temples in Varanasi hold special significance, and thus it is known as the city of temples!

Tourist Places 11.



Bharat Mata Mandir (meaning "Mother India Temple") is located on the Mahatma Gandhi Kashi Vidyapith campus in Varanasi, Uttar Pradesh, India. Instead of traditional statues of gods and goddesses, this temple has a huge map of undivided India carved in marble. This temple is dedicated to Bharat Mata and claims to be the only one of its kind in the world.



BHU, New Vishwanath Temple and Birla Temple is one of the most famous Hindu temples and biggest tourist attractions in the holy city of Varanasi. The temple is situated in Banaras Hindu University and is dedicated to the Lord Shiva. Shri Vishwanath Mandir has the tallest temple tower in the world with the Shikhara's height being around 250 feet



GHATS: According to the puranic sources, there are five key ghats on the riverfront which are important because of their association with a defining feature of the holy city of Kashi: Assi Ghat, Dashashwamedh Ghat, Manikarnika Ghat, Panchganga Ghat, Rajendra Prasad Ghat, and Adi Keshav Ghat. Every Ghats have different history.





- **SARNATH** is where Gautama Buddha first taught the Dharma.
- The Lion Capital of Ashoka is the capital, or head, of a column erected by the Mauryan emperor Ashoka in Sarnath, India, c. 250 BCE.
- Ashok chakra is the national emblem of India.
