How To Reach Amritsar

By Air



The Sri Guru Ram Das Jee International Airport of Amritsar Located around 11 km away from the citycenter, has more than 160 domestic and international flights.

Sri Guru Ram Das Jee International Airport located North-West in the city of Amritsar makes it possible for all to get regular flights all throughout the day & Night. It connects with several important cities of the country as well as with the Globe.



By Train

The Amritsar Railway Station connects the city to almost all major Indian cities including Delhi, Bathinda, Ambala, Pathankot, Jammu, Mumbai, Hyderabad, Agra, Ahmedabad, Kolkata, and Chandigarh etc. A train journey from Delhi to Amritsar takes about 6-7 hours



By Bus

Being located on the National Highway 1, Amritsar is well connected by road. Daily bus services, including both Government and Private run, to and from Ambala, Patiala, Bathinda, Delhi, Gurgaon, Chandigarh, and Jammu etc. The G.T Road links Delhi (464 km) to Amritsar. Luxury/ deluxe buses and cabs are also available from here that connects the city with all the important places of India daily.


TOURIST DESTINATIONS

The Golden Temple



The Golden Temple, also known as Sri Harmandir Sahib is a highly revered religious Sikh shrine and symbolizes equality and human brotherhood. The gurudwara epitomizes the distinctive heritage and identity of Sikhs while glorifying their ideals. After its compilation, Sri Guru Granth Sahib (scripture of the Sikhs) was first installed at Sri Harmandir Sahib on 16th August 1604. At this soothing site, everybody can seek religious fulfillment and spiritual solace, irrespective of the caste.

The Durgiana Temple



Durgiana Temple, also known as Lakshmi Narayan Temple, is a Hindu temple located in the city of Amritsar located around 1.6 Km from the Golden Temple. It bears a stark resemblance to the famous Golden Temple while also carrying the same sense of peace, tranquillity and spirituality. Within this historic temple lies a beautiful Sarovar where one can find idols of Goddess Lakshmi and Lord Vishnu floating. The rare sculpture of the sitting Hanuman, considered one of a kind, is found in the temple premises. One of the main highlights at the temple is the fountain show which takes place in front of the main temple every evening.

Shri Ram Tirth Temple



Shri Ram Tirth Temple, located near Amritsar city, was built to honor the birthplace of Luva - Kusha, twins of Rama and Sita. Constructed in lime yellow stone, the temple dates back to the epic of Ramayana where Sita was given in the Ashram of Balamiki after being abandoned by Rama. The battle of Ram's Ashwamedha force with Luv-Kush is said to have taken place here. The gurukul of the twins, situated in the temple compound, is regarded as an architectural wonder by pilgrims.

Attari Border



One of the best places to visit near Amritsar, Attari/ Wagah Border is marked with a patriotic high. Located around 30 km from the city centre, it is the only road border crossing that runs between India and Pakistan. Every evening, the border turns into a ceremonial ground before the sunset and attracts hordes of tourists. It is the time when soldiers belonging to both the countries engage in Beating Retreat and Change of Guard ceremonies. It is a daily practice when the lowering of the national flag takes place on both sides of the border by the soldiers, accompanied with elaborate and quick military exercises.
